How does this lead me to my husband? Well, the following week I'm about to delete an app off my phone called "Facebook Dating". Suddenly, this handsome man's picture pops up and his bio said how he loves Jesus and was a worship leader.

I instantly "liked" his page alerting him that we had matched. The rest is history, and as I like to say, it was love at first "like".

Later on it came to my mom's remembrance of my dream I had in the hospital and she told me, "your dream had double meaning! You met the man you were supposed to be with and are literally starting a new life with him. Plus you are healed of those horrible thoughts!"

What was potentially the worst time in my life became one of my favorite stories, or testimonies, to share! You truly never know what God has in store for you!
